Welcome to FAVILLE!

FAVILLE aims to enhance the quality standards of facilitation in virtual learning environments and to provide skills and competences that facilitators of virtual learning need to develop or improve their activity.

The project aims to intervene in a constantly growing virtual learning industry, in which, despite the increasing amount of offer of different learning programmes- even free of charge - there is still a lack of qualified facilitators of the learning process, using new educational technologies.

The aim of the project will be achieved by creating three main project outputs: e-learning course for virtual learning facilitators, Digital App on facilitation techniques, and Framework for validation of skills and competences of virtual learning facilitators acquired through non-formal and informal learning, all to be pilot-tested once ready.

FAVILLE's partnership consists of seven partners from five different counties including universities, NGO's, SME's and research centres.

FAVILLE Results

Desk research and expert interviews

As part of the Intelectual Output 1 of FAVILLE's project, a desk research was developed aimed to provide an overview on existing information regarding e-learning facilitators and their training needs in the partner countries.

Some of the aspects considered were:

 Facilitation of virtual/e-learning is considered as a highly relevant task in all partner countries, It is however not always considered as a full occupational profile but is often linked to the duties of teachers.

















- · The use of elearning is quite common mainly in higher education and vocational training, it is less established in the liberal or community-based adult learning sector.
- · Many of those working in elearning are self-taught, there are no professional standards for that area in the partner countries and formal regulations are lacking so far. Apart from a number of comprehensive high-cost training courses, training provision on virtual learning facilitation is patchy, and many facilitators of virtual learning lack appropriate skills
